Frank Mahoney called the meeting to order at 5:19 pm

1. Election of Officers: Slates of officers presented:

1. Robert Wilkins nominated Frank Mahoney, president, Glenn Harter vice president, and Robert Wilkins, secretary/treasurer; Judy Nommik second.

2. Glenn Harter nominated Rob Moore, president; Frank Mahoney, vice president, Robert Wilkins, secretary/treasurer. Rob More amended the slate of nominations to Frank Mahoney, President; Rob Moore, Vice President; and Robert Wilkins as Secretary/Treasurer. Glenn seconded: Slate of officers Passed as Frank Mahoney, President; Rob Moore as Vice President and Robert Wilkins as Secretary/Treasurer.

2. Other Business added: Rob Moore made a motion to rescind the vote last month to reduce Administrative Staff salaries and hours and restore the hours and salaries to 40 per week immediately, Robert Wilkins seconded. Discussion was presented that the financial concerns are still present due to concerns about Medicaid which is a large portion of what RCT has. Mary explained that DVHA has agreed with RCT that the count that was used for Stagecoach starting in July was incorrect and the money needs to be returned to RCT. Medicaid is working with VPTA to come into compliance. The motion passed.
