Provide public transportation services for everyone that are safe, reliable, accessible and affordable to enhance the economic, social and environmental health of the community we serve.

Our Vision

Establish a solid foundation for regional development of a safe, efficient public transportation system.

Rural Community Transportation, Inc. (RCT), is a private nonprofit 501(c)(3) corporation which provides public transportation services throughout Caledonia, Orleans, Essex and Lamoille Counties, RCT operates fare-free shuttle and commuter bus routes connecting towns in our region and enabling travel throughout Vermont and beyond. RCT operates Microtransit services called, "The Hymor" throughout Morrisville, Hyde Park and Elmore. In addition, RCT provides demand-response transportation services under programs such as Medicaid, the Elderly & Disabled program, and Rides 2 Wellness. RCT continues to grow and do our part to keep our community healthy and safe.





RCT Continues to provide one of the most tangible and impactful services in the Northeast Kingdom and Lamoille County. I am amazed daily by the challenges, impact, and rewards that working in the transportation field presents. We have removed transportation barriers throughout our service area in the face of blizzards, flooding, broken-down vehicles, mental health and physical crises. Over the past year, RCT's drivers and staff continued to provide exceptional service as we improved our foundation and expanded our offerings. RCT launched its first microtransit service in the Morrisville area in June 2024. Microtransit brings with it the possibility of rider agency and freedom. I look forward to our new services' continued success and the possibility of expanding to other towns in our area.

I cannot wait to see what the next year brings as we enter a transit development plan, a strategic plan, and a comprehensive rebrand. RCT is strong, and the coming year will make us more durable and sustaining. In the meantime, we will continue to remove transportation barriers and make life better for the people and communities we serve.

Bus Service

In FY23, RCT buses traveled a total of 64,794 miles across our service areas of Caledonia, Essex, Orleans and Lamoille Counties, with service points in Washington County. Our bus service connects passengers to destinations throughout and beyond Vermont.

The RCT Shuttle/Commuter/Shopper Bus system keeps people connected to work and family and community.

RCT is committed to efficient travel and reducing Fossil Fuel consumption. In FY23, RCT continued work to put electric vehicles on the road.

Dial-A-Ride

In FY23, NEK residents received 109,252 Dial-A-Ride Program rides to health care appointments, jobs, school and more. RCT was honored to provide essential rides with safety as priority.





Microtransit

In FY23, RCT implemented a Microtransit service called "The Hymor". The service runs 8AM to 5PM Monday through Friday, except holidays. Service is available in Morrisville, Hyde Park and Elmore to and from any address in the service area for any and all transportation needs. Riders can book a ride through our "RCT Microtransit" app or by calling RCT.


